

A COVID-19 Testing Site opened Wednesday, April 1st at Cooper's Poynt Waterfront Park in Camden where residents will be able to drive or walk up.

This site will also be open weekdays, from noon until 4 p.m. through April 15th.

Officials said there are big things to remember for testing:

- You will need a recommendation from your primary care physician to be tested
- You must be showing symptoms
- You need to make an appointment to be tested

Local health departments recommend people who have mild symptoms to stay at home.

If you have severe symptoms - a fever over 100 degrees, shortness of breath, and cough - then officials say to call your health care provider.
