Title VI Policy Statement

The Township of Waterford is committed to ensuring that no person is excluded from participation, denied benefits or otherwise subjected to discrimination under any program or activity on the basis of race, color, national origin, sex, age, or disability.

The Township of Waterford as a recipient of federal, state and county financial assistance will ensure full compliance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, as amended, and related Statutes and regulations in all Township of Waterford programs and activities.

The Township Administrator's Office shall have the responsibility for Title VI activities. The Township Administrator can be reached at (856) 768-2300, ext. 224 and the office is located at 2131 Auburn Ave, Atco, New Jersey 08004

Any person who believes that he or she has been subjected to discrimination or retaliation based on their race, color, national origin, sex, age, or disability may file a Title VI complaint. Complaints may be filed directly to the Township Administrator or to the Federal, State or County Funding agency. Complaints must be filed in writing and signed by the complainant or a representative and should include the complainants name, address and telephone number or other means by which the complainant can be contacted. Complaints must be filed within 180 days of the date the alleged discriminatory act.
