DISCUSSION TOOK PLACE REGARDING RULES OF CONFLICT RE: ENGINEER AND A PLANNER

Mr. Wells gave an overview of the role of being a member of the Planning board as outlined in New Jersey Statutes. He also reviewed Board policies. He explained the ethical standards and conduct expected of Board members when addressing conflicts with professionals and applicants who come before the Board.

b. Policy on Board members missing meetings.

Mr. Toussaint related the law regarding Board members responsibility/acceptable reasons for missing Board meetings. He stated that Chapter 40 of NJSA specifically delineates the acceptable reasons for missing a meeting. A Board member can be removed from the Board if he/she misses eight weeks or four consecutive meetings. **Chairman Condo commented a vote will be taken as needed on the approval or disapproval of the request for excused absences.**

c. Destroying recordings of meetings and record retention program.

Mr. Toussaint related that according to the State approved Retention of Records schedule the recordings (disc) of Board meetings can be destroyed/erased one year after the adoption of the minutes of the meeting. **The Board directed Mr. Toussaint to destroy recordings according to our retention schedule.**
