1. Call Meeting to Order at 7:32 P.M.

3. Meeting Open to Public – None Attending.
4. Minutes approved: NONE . Chair having problems with recording equipment. Discussed if it would be possible to have minutes done by non-member + paid for by Clean Communities Fund.
5. Atco Lake Mosquito Control: Bat Houses – The Buffington’s delivered 4 Bat Houses from Cub Scout Pack 95. Rick Yeatman to contact Sal Russomanno for metal poles that he volunteered to provide.
6. Stormwater Drain Management. Municipal Engineers looking into cost to provide an updated ‘Stormwater Outflow Map. R. Yeatman needs to draft a formal letter requesting spraying or other control methods which could be done by the State or County with a copy to other local Envir. Commissions seeking support.
7. Groundwater Mercury Contamination: 15 individuals attended the Open Public meeting that the WTEC held at the Atco Senior Citizens Center. R. Yeatman presented up-to-date information on the contamination issue. Attendees indicated that they received all lthe information that they needed. Still waiting for stormwater retention basin testing for Mercury contamination.
8. Owens Corning: Discussed Permanent sampling wells that have been installed around the perimeter of the plume. OC will sample them on a routine quarterly basis to determine extent and potential plume movement.
9. Spring Clean-up. Event was successful. Approx. 60 volunteers participated and 15 households dropped off unwanted electronics. Wade Salvage was requested to provide smaller dumpsters in the future. No additional food was needed to be purchased. Discussed up-dating the ‘Clementon Gun Club’ sign on the corner of Lincoln and Tremont. T. Chiddenton will contact CG Club to see if they would allow us to do this for them. It would allow our residents to find the Gun Club easier. R. Yeatman asked for Motion to pre-approve up to \$100 for this project. Vote was unanimous in favor of motion. A mention was made that the WTEC Trailer needs a license plate. D. Chiddenton will contact Twp Administrator on this matter.
10. Camden Cnty Household Haz. Waste Day – (5/18/13). Flyers on Lawncare will be handed out. R. Yeatman + R. Beswick to put up banners advertising the event.
11. Atco Lake Fishing Derby (June 15th) Members need to begin handing out flyers to Vendors requesting Trophy or Prize donations.
