**ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WATERFORD  
AMENDING CHAPTER 208 OF THE CODE OF THE  
TOWNSHIP OF WATERFORD, CAPTIONED  
“PEDDLING AND SOLICITING”**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the foregoing ordinance was introduced and passed on first reading at a meeting of the Township Committee of the Township of Waterford, held on April 12, 2017. Ordinance #2017-14 amends the Township’s current Chapter 208 entitled Peddling and Soliciting to amend the requirements for the issuance of this type of license. Amendments include the issuance of an identification badge to be worn by solicitors at all times, restricting the allowable time period for solicitation to Monday through Saturday 9a.m. to 7p.m. or dusk, whichever occurs earlier and further amends licensee fees and the duration of a license period to six-months. Ordinance #2017-14 will be further considered for final passage after public hearing at a meeting of said Township Committee to be held in the Waterford Township Municipal Building, 2131 Auburn Avenue, Atco, New Jersey, on April 26, 2017, beginning at 7:00 P.M., at which time and place all persons interested will be given an opportunity to be heard concerning such ordinance. Copies of this Ordinance shall be made immediately available at the Township Clerk’s Office in said Municipal Building at no cost to those members of the general public requesting same.
