**ORDINANCE # 2015-14**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 235 OF THE CODE OF THE  
TOWNSHIP OF WATERFORD, COUNTY OF CAMDEN AND STATE  
OF NEW JERSEY CAPTIONED "SOLID WASTE"**

**WHEREAS**, upon a review of Chapter 235 captioned "Solid Waste" it has been determined that certain amendments are required in regard to the definitions of "YARD WASTE" and "BRUSH."

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Mayor and Township Committee of the Township of Waterford, County of Camden, and State of New Jersey, as follows:

**SECTION 1.** Chapter 235 captioned "Solid Waste" shall be amended as follows:

Section 235-2A(11) captioned "YARD WASTE" shall be changed to read:

"Leaves, twigs, small branches and weeds shall be placed into open containers."

Section 235-2A(11) captioned "BRUSH" shall be changed to read:

"Tree limbs and branches of up to a maximum of six (6") inches in diameter shall be placed no higher than four (4') feet in height and no more than twenty (20') feet in length and placed curbside. Christmas trees must have lights and stands removed before pickup. Bushes, hedges and other small trees not balled, with a maximum of two (2") inches in diameter. No vegetative waste, vines or briars.

Section 235-2A is amended to add the following definitions:

(17) CHIPPING

Residents shall call the Department of Public Works to have their brush placed on a list for chipping. Brush shall be no more than six (6") inches in diameter and should be neatly stacked and placed at the curb. Piles shall be no more than twenty (20') feet in length and four (4') feet in height with the thickest part of the limb facing the street.

(18) LOT CLEARING

Total tree removal/logs and complete land clearing or remains of the land by privately hired contractors shall not be subject to pick up or collection by the Township Public Works Department.


Section 235-9 captioned "Placement of Material for Collection" shall be changed to add the following:


"H" Residents shall put out yard and brush collection only on the first full week of each month on the designated solid waste collection day.

**SECTION 2.** All Ordinances or parts of ordinances which are inconsistent with any provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed as to the extent of such inconsistencies.

**SECTION 3.** If any provisions of any section, sub-section, paragraph, subdivision or clause of this amended Ordinance shall be judged invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such Order or Judgment shall not effect or invalidate the remainder of any section, sub-section, paragraph, subdivision or clause of this amended Ordinance.

**SECTION 4.** This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon adoption and publication as required by law and Certification by the New Jersey Pinelands Commission.


