**ORDINANCE # 2016-10**

**ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WATERFORD AMENDING  
CHAPTER 266 OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WATERFORD  
CAPTIONED “VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC”**

**WHEREAS**, the Waterford Township Police Department has reviewed traffic speed issues on 3<sup>rd</sup> Street between Jackson Road and Raritan Avenue and East Atlantic Avenue between the Old White Horse Pike Bridge and Bartram Avenue; and

**WHEREAS**, as a result of the traffic studies performed on these two roadways, it has been determined there is sufficient motor vehicles travelling at speeds unsafe for residents who reside on both sides of these roadways, including students waiting at bus stops; and

**WHEREAS**, as a result, it is the recommendation of the Waterford Township Police Chief that each of these roadways have a speed limit of 35 miles per hour the entire length of each roadway.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Mayor and Township Committee of the Township of Waterford, County of Camden, and State of New Jersey as follows:

**SECTION 1.** Chapter 266 of the Code of Waterford Township captioned “Vehicles and Traffic”, Section 266-11 shall be amended as follows:


<b>NAME OF STREET</b>	<b>SPEED LIMIT/MPH</b>	<b>LOCATION</b>
3 <sup>rd</sup> Street	35	Between Jackson Road and Raritan Avenue
East Atlantic Avenue	35	Between the Old White Horse Pike Bridge and Bartram Avenue


**SECTION 2:** Upon adoption of this Ordinance, proper regulatory and warning signs shall be erected and maintained to affect the above designated speed limits as authorized by this Ordinance.

**SECTION 3: SEVERABILITY.** If any section, subsection, part, clause of this Ordinance shall be declared invalid by judgment of any Court of competent jurisdiction, such section, subsection, part, clause or phrase shall be deemed to be severable from the remainder of this Ordinance and the remainder of this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

**SECTION 4: REPEALER.** All Ordinances or portions of Ordinances thereof inconsistent with this Ordinance are repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

**SECTION 5: ADOPTION.** This Ordinance shall take effect immediately after final passage and publication according to law and any approval required from the County of Camden.
