ORDINANCE # 2016 -22

**ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WATERFORD AMENDING
CHAPTER 69 OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WATERFORD
CAPTIONED "VOLUNTEER FIRE FIGHTERS AND EMS SQUAD"**

WHEREAS, on a periodic basis, the Township of Waterford staff and Fire Department reviews various Chapters of the Township Code in order to keep said Code Book current; and

WHEREAS, as a result, it has been determined that certain amendments should be made to Chapter 69 captioned "Volunteer Fire Fighters and EMS Squad" as set forth herein below.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Township Committee of the Township of Waterford, County of Camden, and State of New Jersey as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 69 of the Code of the Township of Waterford captioned "Volunteer Fire Fighters and EMS Squad" shall be amended as follows:

1. The caption of the Ordinance shall be changed to read "Volunteer Fire Fighters".
2. All references to "EMS Squad and EMS Squad Member" shall be removed.
3. Section 69-2 captioned "Budgeting of Funds; Amount; Allocation," Paragraph B, shall be amended to read as follows:

Amount; Allocation. The amount placed into the annual budget for this purpose shall be at the discretion of the Township Committee.

A new paragraph C shall be added to Section 69-2 which shall read as follows:

"At the discretion of the Township Committee, the amount placed into the annual budget for the purpose of duty crew shall not exceed the sum of \$4,160 per budget year. Each qualified firefighter assigned to work duty crew assignment will receive not more than \$20 per shift. The duty crew stipend will be paid to a volunteer firefighter who meets the identified eligibility requirements set forth in Chapter 69-3 paragraph A.

SECTION 2.

All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances, inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

SECTION 3.


If the provisions of any section, subsection, paragraph, subdivision, or clause of the Ordinance shall be judged invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such order of judgment shall not affect or invalidate the remainder of any section, subsection, paragraph, subdivision, or clause of the Ordinance.

SECTION 4.

This Ordinance shall take effect after final adoption and publication as required by law.
