

## Solid Waste & Recycling

Place at curbside by 5am the day of your scheduled collection. All garbage/trash must be placed inside suitable bags and in the Waterford Township / Republic Services issued container. Material should not be sticking out of the can. Loose bags or non-approved traditional containers will not be collected.

### **Bulk Items**

Items such as couches and furniture can be placed at the curb for pickup during the **last full week of the month, and is collected on your regular trash day**. The hauler will regularly pick up 2 small bulk items at a stop. For example: twin mattress, small chair, small table, etc. With the beginning of the new collection system, bulk trash pick-up for oversized/large items will be **one (1)** time a month during the last full week of the month (a full week of the month is the last week which includes Monday to Friday of the same month). **Construction and/or remodeling material is not bulk trash and is not collected by the Township or Servicer.** If you have any questions please contact Public Works (856) 767-2359.

### **Bulk Items That Will Not Be Collected**

The Township is not permitted to dispose of construction and remodeling materials at the incinerator. The Township **will not** collect debris such as paneling, insulation, decks, fences, railroad ties, bricks, concrete, roofing, etc. **Contractors and homeowners are responsible for the removal and disposal of these items.**

*\*\*Beginning March 2018 the Township will be offering a Convenience Center located at 790 Burnt Mill Road where residents may dispose of construction debris from do-it-yourself homeowner projects. More information to follow\*\**

### **Batteries**

It is no longer necessary to recycle regular A, AA, AAA, C and D alkaline batteries. Manufacturers have been mandated to reduce the level of mercury in them and they may now be thrown away in your regular trash

## **Brush and Yard Waste**

Brush and Yard Waste, excluding grass, are picked up the first full week, on your normally scheduled trash collection day, of each month during the months of March to November. Brush must be tied into bundles, not exceed 4 feet in length or placed in cans, not to exceed 50lbs. **There is no need to call for a brush pickup.** Brush not meeting the above specifications will not be picked up.

Christmas trees, bushes, hedges and other small non-balled trees, with a maximum of 2 inches in diameter may be called into the Public Works Department to be placed on a pickup list

Residents may dispose of their own brush and leaves at the Columbia Ave PIT on certain Saturday's from 9am to 1pm. Residents will be required to show identification proving residency. Please contact Public Works at 856-767-2359 for a list of scheduled Saturdays.

## **Tires**

Car, bicycle and small truck tires may be put out for curbside collection. No more than two (2) per week. Please be sure to have the rim removed from the tire.

## **Paints**

Latex paints and empty containers are not hazardous waste and should be disposed of in your regular trash. Collectors require that they be air dried with lids removed to ensure pick up by our waste hauler. It is recommended to use kitty litter or sand as a drying agent.

## **Hazardous Household Waste**

Oil based paints, pesticides, fertilizers, solvents, automotive product, etc. will not be accepted with your regular trash collection nor will the Township D.P.W. Complex accept it. ## **White Goods**

White Goods consist of refrigerators (doors must be off), washers, dryers, dishwashers, stoves, swing sets (concrete must be removed), lawn mowers, water heaters and all other metal appliances. White Goods will be picked up by scheduling with Public Works. Please contact the office at 856-767-2359 during the hours of 8:00am and 3:00pm, Monday to Friday

### **Acceptable Commingled Recyclables**

All aluminum cans, plastic containers, cardboard and glass bottles are to be put together in the 95 gallon recycle container provided by the Township. Recyclables are to be placed in your recycling container and placed on the curb-line by 5am on your assigned collection day. **DO NOT PUT RECYCLABLES IN PLASTIC BAGS**

*Aluminum Food and Beverage Containers* – Aluminum soda and beer cans, cat food cans, etc.

*Glass Food and Beverage Containers* – Flint (clear), Amber (brown), Emerald (green)

*Ferrous Cans* – Soup, coffee, etc.

*P.E.T* – Plastic Containers with the #1 Symbol

*H.D.P.E* – Natural Plastic Containers with the #2 Symbol

*H.D.P.E Pigmented Plastic Containers* – detergent, shampoo, bleach bottles etc. with the #2 Symbol and **without** caps on them

*Plastic Numbers 4, 5, and 7* – are now being recycled. This means items such as yogurt containers, microwave containers, windex bottles, ketchup squeeze bottles and medicine bottles are now all recyclable
