The time of soliciting, peddling, hawking, vending and canvasing shall be between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. or sunset, whichever occurs earlier, Monday through Saturday. [Amended 4-26-2017 by Ord. No. 2017-14]

- (1) The aforesaid time limitation shall apply unless such a person or permit holder has been invited to a dwelling by an occupant of said dwelling, or shall have previously made an appointment with the occupant of the dwelling.
- (2) When the sale or attempted sale of the merchandise is not involved, and canvasing and soliciting is in connection with a political campaign or charitable or religious organization recognized as tax exempt under the United States Internal Revenue Code, solicitation may take place from 9:00 a.m. to sunset, Monday through Sunday, unless other arrangements have been made with the occupant.
