

**NOTICE OF PENDING ORDINANCE  
TOWNSHIP OF WATERFORD  
COUNTY OF CAMDEN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY  
ORDINANCE # 2018 - 17**

**AMENDING CHAPTER 94, ARTICLE II CAPTIONED “HORSES”**

**WHEREAS**, on a periodic basis the Township of Waterford reviews its Ordinances for any revisions determined to be appropriate; and

**WHEREAS**, upon a review of Chapter 94, Article II captioned “Horses” it has been determined that this should be amended to provide clarification as to all Zoning Districts where horses are to be permitted to be boarded, sheltered or housed.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Mayor and Township Committee of the Township of Waterford, County of Camden, State of New Jersey, as follows:

**Section 1.** Chapter 94 of the Code of the Township of Waterford captioned “Animals,” Article II captioned “Horses” Paragraph 30 captioned “Exemptions” is hereby amended to read as follows:

“Any registered farmer shall be exempted from the provisions of this Article.”

**Section 2.** All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances that are inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency only.

**Section 3.** If the provisions of any section, subsection, paragraph, subdivision, or clause of this Ordinance shall be judged invalid by a Court of competent jurisdiction, such order of judgment shall not affect or invalidate the remainder of any section, subsection, paragraph, subdivision or clause of this Ordinance.

**Section 4.** This Ordinance shall only take effect after final adoption and publication as required by law.

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the foregoing ordinance was introduced and passed on first reading at a meeting of the Township Committee of the Township of Waterford, held on July 11, 2018. It will be further considered for final passage after public hearing at a meeting of said Township Committee to be held in the Waterford Township Municipal Building, 2131 Auburn Avenue, Atco, New Jersey, on July 25, 2018, beginning at 7:00 P.M., at which time and place all persons interested will be given an opportunity to be heard concerning such ordinance. Copies of this Ordinance shall be made immediately available at the Township Clerk's Office in said Municipal Building at no cost to those members of the general public requesting same.
