**ORDINANCE NO. 2022-15**

**ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WATERFORD AMENDING CHAPTER 235  
CAPTIONED "SOLID WASTE"**

**WHEREAS**, in order to assist in the Township collection of solid waste, it has been determined to amend Chapter 235 captioned "Solid Waste" to include a manner for yard waste collection.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Mayor and Township Committee of the Township of Waterford, County of Camden, State of New Jersey, as follows:

**Section 1.** Chapter 235 of the Code of the Township of Waterford captioned "Solid Waste" is hereby amended as follows:

Chapter 235-4 captioned "Prohibited Materials and/or Conduct" is amended to include a new paragraph G and which shall read as follows:


"G. Yard Waste Collection - Branches and brush shall be cut in four (4) foot lengths and tied or bundled securely with string or twine or otherwise placed in proper containers with suitable handles, such as the former yellow recycling cans, clearly marked "Yard Waste", and all the aforementioned shall be no more than ten (10) bundles or cans collectively at any one time and be of such weight and design as to be conveniently handled by one (1) person, and no bundle or receptical with its contents, shall weigh more than fifty (50) pounds. All bundles and cans shall be placed neatly on the curb. Logs shall be cut in one and one half (1.5) foot lengths and placed at the curb, no more than 20 logs at any one time. If logs are unable to be picked up by one man, the logs will be left curbside. No stumps are permitted."

**Section 2.** All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances that are inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency only.

**Section 3.** If the provisions of any section, subsection, paragraph, subdivision, or clause of this Ordinance shall be judged invalid by a Court of competent jurisdiction, such order of judgment shall not affect or invalidate the remainder of any section, subsection, paragraph, subdivision or clause of this Ordinance.

**Section 4.** This Ordinance shall only take effect after final adoption and publication as required by law.
